RE: Now Is The Moment To Accelerate the Just, Renewable Energy Future and End the Fossil Fuel Era

Dear President Biden,

We urge you to seize this moment to end our dependence on fossil fuels by building an equitable, just and renewable energy system for all.

Humanity now faces a cascade of emergencies. The Russian military, business and political elites around President Putin are committing brutal crimes in Russia's war of aggression in Ukraine, annihilating basic principles of state sovereignty and undermining democracy. At the same time, the climate crisis is wreaking an "<u>atlas of human suffering</u>". These crises may seem entirely independent, but they share the same dangerous thread: dependence on fossil fuels. Fossil fuels fund not only Putin's war crimes but other conflicts around the world, provoke war and militarism for fossil fuel resources, and drive the climate emergency.

Therefore, we call on all countries opposed to fossil-fueled wars and committed to addressing climate chaos to urgently:

<u>End the fossil fuel era</u>. Russia's invasion into Ukraine is fueled by their fossil fuel extraction power, and the world's reliance upon it. Fossil fuel companies drive parallel plastics, air, soil and water pollution, species extinction and biodiversity crises; cause enormous ecological destruction in their production; entrench global systems of colonialism, racism, and ecocide; and fossil fuel pollution <u>causes</u> 1 in 5 deaths per year. War makes it more apparent that fossil fuel dependence puts people at risk and makes energy systems insecure. We recognize that there are wars across the world – many driven by our collective dependence on fossil fuels and resources – and also express our deepest solidarity with the victims of armed conflicts that impact millions of human and non-human lives.

Fossil fuels are also the primary driver of the climate crisis and sow the destruction captured in the United Nations <u>report</u> from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change. The International Energy Agency <u>showed</u> that the world must immediately stop all new fossil fuel investments to meet the survival target for many vulnerable and poor communities, Island nations, and fragile ecosystems. To preserve a livable planet, we must:

- End the expansion of the fossil fuel industry by stopping all new public financing and prohibiting private financing, exploration licenses or permits for coal, oil, and gas extraction, exports and infrastructure. Rich countries like the United States, Canada, Australia, Japan, and the United Kingdom <u>need to stop</u> all coal extraction by 2030 and oil and gas extraction by 2031, while all other countries <u>must stop</u> shortly thereafter, to have a decent chance at limiting global warming to 1.5°C.
- Phase out nuclear energy as an inherently dirty, dangerous and costly energy source.
- Tax windfall profits, stop subsidies, and shift financial systems away from the support of the fossil fuel industry to ensure for-profit fossil fuel utility companies, which have obstructed the renewable energy transition, should not reap benefits of this transition.
- Create an international plan for an equitable phase out of fossil fuel production and use in line with the 1.5°C target, recognizing the historical responsibility of rich industrialized countries

for the climate crisis and the necessity of their leadership, and the different capacity of countries to rapidly transition and diversify their economies. The worst impacts of militarism and fossil-fueled climate catastrophe are largely felt by poorer and marginalized people in the Global South and Black, Indigenous, and other communities of color in the Global North, who are most vulnerable and least responsible for the climate crisis and have the fewest resources to mitigate and adapt to a rapidly changing climate.

Transition to a just and equitable clean, efficient, renewable energy system. Industrial and other rich nations can and must rapidly transform their own domestic systems while cooperating internationally to share resources and launch an energy secure future immune from the global volatility and violence of fossil fuels. Importantly, the renewable energy future must not repeat the violence of the extractive, fossil fuel past. Justice must ground this transition to redress the climate, colonialist, racist, socioeconomic, and ecological injustices of the fossil fuel era. This requires global cooperation to:

- **Expand the deployment of safe, renewable, and just energy systems** across the economy. Build clean energy access for the <u>1 billion people</u> still without electricity, in line with the agreed Sustainable Development Goal 7 to eradicate energy poverty by 2030.
- **Increase energy and resource efficiency** by mandating and incentivizing robust efficiency measures and products.
- **Promote distributed, decentralized renewable energy-based systems,** like roof-based solar, community-owned solar and other energy democracy systems, and mini-grid systems, where appropriate, to maximize climate resilience and affordability, especially in communities at the frontlines of the climate crisis. Support larger scale renewable energy projects like offshore wind energy for cities and industries, as appropriate, where decentralized energy does not provide sufficient power and avoid negative impacts on ecosystems.
- Ensure a circular economy and responsible extraction of renewable energy minerals that uphold human and Indigenous rights, avoids ecological and social negative impacts on freshwater and groundwater, land, air, ecosystems and imperiled species, excludes seabed mining, and prioritizes recycling and extending the life of materials used in renewable and energy efficiency technologies.
- Embark on new local, regional, national and international agreements and approaches to drastically scale up the transfer of technology and finance in addition to meeting existing commitments and needs for climate mitigation, adaptation, and loss and damage resourcing to ensure all countries, communities, and workers are able to undertake a just transition from the fossil fuel economy.

This is the opportunity of our lifetimes to stop the violence of fossil fuels and build a new era of peace and justice to confront the climate crisis.¹
